**Subject: Improving the working environment - Greenery in Members' offices in Brussels and common areas in all European Parliament buildings**

As studies show, plants have a positive impact on the working environment, making it more attractive, improving air quality, and boosting well-being in general. As a follow-up to the refurbishment of Members' offices, it was therefore proposed to put in place a generalised and structured approach for the distribution of plants in offices, and to bring forward guidelines in this regard.

On the basis of this proposal, each Member can request two suitably sized plants from the One-Stop Shop for Members Unit, either for their own office or the offices of their assistants in Brussels. In addition, common areas in all European Parliament buildings will be gradually furnished with adequate greenery.
